

AWARD FOR THE DEPARTING CONSUL GENERAL OF RUSSIA IN ALEXANDRIA BY HIS BEATITUDE

On 16th June 2010 His Beatitude Theodoros II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa accompanied by His Grace Gennadios Bishop of Nilopolis Chancellor of the Holy Synod and Mr. Apostolos Trifyllis, Director of the Patriarchal Library of Alexandria, attended the farewell reception of the Honourable Consul General of Russia in Alexandria, Mr. Dimitri Kourakov, on the completion of his Consular tenure in the Great City.
