EGYPT'S GIFT TO PATRIARCH THEODOROS

The reconstruction of the Center of the Patriarchate of Alexandria in this area, will give the opportunity to the ancient church of Alexandria, always with modern approaches to new problems, to transmit its universal message, from the center of Orthodoxy to the great Continent of Africa which is expected to play an important role in the global developments of the 21st century.

"This new center of Orthodoxy in the New Administrative Capital will also be the beacon for the missionary work of the patriarchate on our long-suffering continent," said the Primate of the Orthodox Church of Africa.

And as the Alexandrian Primate pointed out, "this donation demonstrates in practice the appreciation of the President of Egypt Abdel Fattah Al Sisi for the Ancient Patriarchate of Alexandria and consequently for Hellenism in Egypt and confirms the indestructible ties of Hellenism with the Egyptian people.

The new capital is expected to house 6.5 million people in the area between the Nile River and the Suez Canal, east of Cairo.

It is temporarily called the New Administrative Capital and will be the largest, most luxurious, modern and newest capital in the world.
