HIS BEATITUDE MEETS WITH HIS EXCELLENCY THE AMBASSADOR OF EGYPT IN ZIMBABWE

On 11th October 2011, His Beatitude Theodoros II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa paid an official visit to His Excellency the Ambassador of Egypt in Zimbabwe, Mr Basem Halil, who hosted an official lunch in his honour at the Ambassadorial residence in Harare.
