

HIS BEATITUDE MEETS WITH THE GOVERNOR OF LUBUMBASHI – INAUGURATION OF THE “FR. KOSMAS” MISSIONARY VILLAGE

On 16th October 2012 His Beatitude Theodoros II Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, accompanied by His Grace Meletios Bishop of Katanga, visited the Governor of the city of Lubumbashi, Honourable Mr. Katumbi Chapwe Moise, to whom he expressed gratitude for the support shown for the work of the Holy Diocese of Katanga. The Honourable Governor expressed his appreciation for the multilevel contribution of the local Church, and defined His Beatitude's visit as a great honour and blessing for the local community, asking for a Patriarchal blessing for a personal matter.
