## HIS BEATITUDE WARMLY WELCOMED IN MADAGASCAR

On 14th february 2008, His Beatitude Theodoros II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa was welcomed to Madagascar with flags, dances, numbers of children who seek their hope in the future.

During the official welcome at the airport, the Primate of the Alexandrian Patriarchate was welcomed by His Grace Ignatios Bishop of Madagascar and the Minister of Foreign Affairs His Excellency Marcel Ranjeva. He will officially declare the operation of a theological seminary in Alasora open, he will inaugurate a new ecclesiastical school in Toulear as well as two churches in Alasora and Abatolamby, together with four hospitals and will be recieved by the President of the country.
