## NEW YEARS EVE AT THE PATRIARCHATE OF ALEXANDRIA

Afterwards, in the Throne Room, His Holiness blessed the new

year St Basil cakes, cut the first piece and then invited the official institutional representatives to cut pieces from the St Basil cakes in turn, an act that, apart from being a Christian custom, also symbolizes the unity of all Egyptian Hellenes in the City of Alexander.

During his address, the venerable Primate of the Alexandrian Church referred to the progress of the arduous missionary work, called on everyone to intensify their prayers for the suffering peoples of Africa, for the immediate cessation of hostilities in the long-suffering Ukraine and in the Middle East which has been hemorrhaging for many years, where man, the living image of God is tortured, destroyed and killed, regardless of race, creed or language, and also for the the unfailing progress and prosperity of Egypt, Greece and Cyprus.
