PASSING OF THE GREAT ARCHIMANDRITE CHRYSOSTOMOS BARBERIS

He ministered faithfully and successfully from the day of his ordination in the Holy Metropolises of Johannesburg and Pretoria, Kenya and finally, in the Holy Metropolis of Aksum, of which he was Chancellor, as well as Parish Priest of the Holy Cathedral of St Frumentius of the Greek Community of Addis Ababa for 33 consecutive years.

He offered his valuable services to Ethiopian Hellenism, taking care of the spiritual, moral and material support of the expatriates in the states of Ethiopia (Addis Ababa and Dire Dawa) and Djibouti. After a short battle with terminal illness, he fell asleep in Athens on September 16, 2023, at the age of 63.
