THE PATRIARCH OF ALEXANDRIA VISITS THE AMERICAN EMBASSY IN CAIRO

His Beatitude Theodoros II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, paid a visit to the Embassy of the United States of America in Cairo. His Beatitude was warmly welcomed to his home, within the grounds of the Embassy by the Chargé d'Affaires Mr. Thomas Goldberg, together with Mr. Patrick Collins, of the department of policy and foreign affairs of the American Embassy.

His Beatitude made extensive mention of the presence of the Patriarchate on the African continent, with particular reference to the enormous missionary and social work done through the Metropolises and the Dioceses of the Patriarchate in the African countries.
