

THE PATRIARCH OF ALEXANDRIA VISITS THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF EGYPT

On the 14th of May 2019, His Beatitude Theodoros II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, accompanied by His Eminence Nikodemos of Memphis, Patriarchal Vicar of Cairo, was warmly welcomed by His Excellency the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Egypt, Mr. Sameh Shoukry.
