THE SUNDAY OF PASCHA AT THE PATRIARCHATE OF ALEXANDRIA

On the Sunday of Pascha, 2nd May 2021, the festive Vespers of the Resurrection was served at the Holy Patriarchal Monastery of St Savvas the Sanctified in Alexandria.
